Event Conditions

ORGANISER

These Event Conditions apply to the International Nurses Day (“Event”), provided by Brickworks Ferry Rd, Dexus Shopping Centres Pty Ltd (ABN 13 001 595 955). The address is Suite 1/107 Ferry Rd, Southport QLD 4215. (“Organiser”) in conjunction with Pearl & Ash Café, ABN 34941034326, and Le Bon Choix, ABN 47684363782 (“Partners”).

1. The “Organiser” is Dexus Shopping Centres Pty Ltd (ABN 13 001 595 955). The address is Suite 1/107 Ferry Rd, Southport QLD 4215.
2. Entry and participation in the Event is subject to these Event Conditions.

ELIGIBILITY

3. This Event is for individuals aged 18 years or over who are Nurses working and residing in Queensland. The participants must be currently employed in a hospital and healthcare facility in Queensland.
4. You must be a Nurse to attend this Event. Participants must present their valid hospital or healthcare ID at the ‘Partner’ venue to redeem the offer outlined below.

EVENT PERIOD AND LOCATION

5. The Event will be conducted at Partner venues Pearl & Ash Café and Lebon Choix at Brickworks Ferry Rd. (“Event Location”).
6. The Event will take place on Tuesday 12 May between 7:00am and 5:00pm AEST.

BOOKING

7. It is free to participate in the Event, no booking must be made.
8. There is a maximum of 200 places available for each session, equating to 100 places at each Partner venue.

TICKET INCLUSIONS

10. Each ticket to the Event includes the following:
 - a. One (1) medium coffee and one (1) mini croissant. A gluten free mini croissant will be offered in place of the plain croissant for dietary reasons. The gluten-free options and milk options are subject to availability.

TRANSFERS, CANCELLATION AND REFUNDS

11. There are no transfers, cancellations or refunds as this a free walk-in event.

RULES OF ENTRY

12. You, and individuals attending under your booking (including children and companions), must comply with all reasonable instructions provided by Event staff and authorised personnel associated with the Event.
13. All participants under the age of 18 must be supervised and accompanied by a parent/guardian at all times.
14. You, and any individuals attending under your booking (including children and companions) must not:
 - a. engage in any conduct that may jeopardise the proper conduct of the Event or the health and safety of staff or participants;
 - b. engage in any conduct that may result in physical damage at the Event Location;
 - c. act in a disruptive, annoying, threatening, abusive or harassing manner, or any other manner that is otherwise inappropriate;
 - d. do anything that may diminish the good name or reputation of the Organiser or Partners or any of their respective related entities or of the agencies or companies associated with this Event; or
 - e. breach any laws.
15. If you or any individuals attending (including children and companions) act in the above manner or otherwise materially breach these Event Conditions, you and those individuals may be refused entry or asked to leave the Event Location and be restricted from participating in the Event, in the Organiser's (or its authorised personnel's) reasonable discretion.

COLLECTION AND USE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

16. The Organiser may use your personal information for such other purposes as set out in the Dexus Group Privacy Policy, which is available at www.dexus.com/who-we-are/privacy-policy. The Dexus Group Privacy Policy also contains information about how participants may access, update or correct their personal information and how participants may make a complaint about how the Organiser handles your personal information and how those complaints will be dealt with. Unless otherwise indicated by the Organiser, the Organiser may provide personal information to entities outside of Australia, for storage and processing only.
17. You agree that, by attending the Event:
 - a) you and any individuals attending (including any children and companions) may be photographed and/or filmed by the Organiser's and/or Partners authorised personnel;
 - b) the images and/or film may be used for future promotional and marketing purposes by the Organiser and Partners with no remuneration; and
 - c) you must not photograph or film other participants at the Event without first obtaining their express consent.

GENERAL

18. By attending the Event, you accept these Event Conditions, forming an agreement between you and the Organiser (each, a "Party").

CHANGES TO THE EVENT

19. The Organiser may make changes to Event (that do not substantially vary the event).
20. The Organiser may reschedule or delay the Event if it determines it is reasonably necessary to do so upon written notice to you.

21. If the Event is interfered with or is not capable of being conducted as reasonably anticipated due to events or reasons beyond the reasonable control of the Organiser (for example, due to security or operational reasons, weather conditions, government directives, a pandemic, public health orders and the like), the Organiser may terminate, suspend or cancel the Event in its reasonable discretion, and if practicable, provide you with reasonable notice, in which event, you will not be entitled to a refund of any amount paid for tickets to the Event (if applicable). If the Event is terminated, suspended or cancelled for any other reason by the Organiser, we will refund you the amount paid for the tickets (if applicable) that could not be fulfilled.

LIABILITY

22. You may have consumer rights under statute including under the Australian Consumer Law ("ACL") in the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (Cth) which may be applicable to the supply of goods or services by us in relation to this Event and cannot be excluded or restricted ("Non-Excludable Guarantees"). Nothing in these Event Conditions excludes or restricts the Non-Excludable Guarantees. See www.accc.gov.au for more information about those rights.
23. To the extent permitted by law, if the Organiser's or Partners' supply of goods or services in connection with the Event or under these Event Conditions is within the meaning prescribed under the AU - ACL the CGA, then the Organiser's or Partners' liability (as applicable) for any failure to comply with a statutory guarantee, condition or warranty that cannot be excluded under statute is limited to (at the Organiser's or Partners' choice (as applicable):
- 24.
- a. in the case of services; the cost of supplying the services again or payment of the cost of having the services supplied again; and
 - b. in the case of goods; the cost of replacing the goods, supplying equivalent goods or having the goods repaired, or payment of the cost of replacing the goods, supplying equivalent goods or having the goods repaired.
25. Subject to paragraphs 22 and 23, neither Party will be liable to the other for consequential, indirect, special, incidental, exemplary or economic damage or loss (including loss of use, loss of revenue, loss of profit, business interruption, costs of procurement of substitution of goods, technology or services or loss of information) arising from a breach of these Event Conditions (including any claim in negligence, equity or otherwise).
26. Except for any liability which under statute, including under the Non-Excludable Guarantees, cannot be excluded (in which case that liability is limited to the greatest extent allowed by law), each Party's total liability to the other Party for any loss, liability or damage suffered by that other Party in connection with the Event or these Event Conditions (including under statute, in contract, negligence, or otherwise) is limited to \$1,000, and will be reduced by the extent (if any) to which the other Party causes or contributes to that loss, liability or damage.
27. All references to the Organiser and Partners in paragraphs 23 – 26 inclusive are references to the Organiser and Partners respectively, and to their respective 'related entities' as defined under the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth) and 'related companies' as defined under the *Companies Act 1993*. where relevant.

MISCELLANEOUS

28. In these Event Conditions, "including" is not a word of limitation.
29. The Organiser may assign, novate or otherwise deal with any of its rights or obligations under these Event Conditions without obtaining your consent, if to do so will be unlikely to cause any material detriment to you.
30. If any provision of these Event Conditions is unlawful or unenforceable, the remaining provisions will continue in full force and effect.

31. These Event Conditions are governed by the laws of Queensland, Australia. and the parties irrevocably submit to the jurisdiction of the courts having jurisdiction in Queensland, Australia.
